Whatever the case, many students find Regina Yutzy-Wolfer teaches to their level, especially their physical level. Photo and story by Matt Wolfer

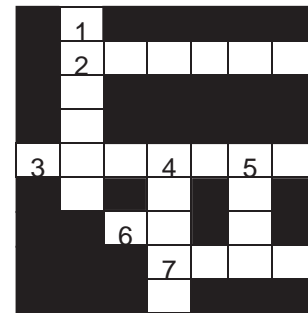
