We also have something new for you to think about. Next year Rosedale Bible Institute will have two camps: Choral Camp, of course, and a new camp called Family Camp.

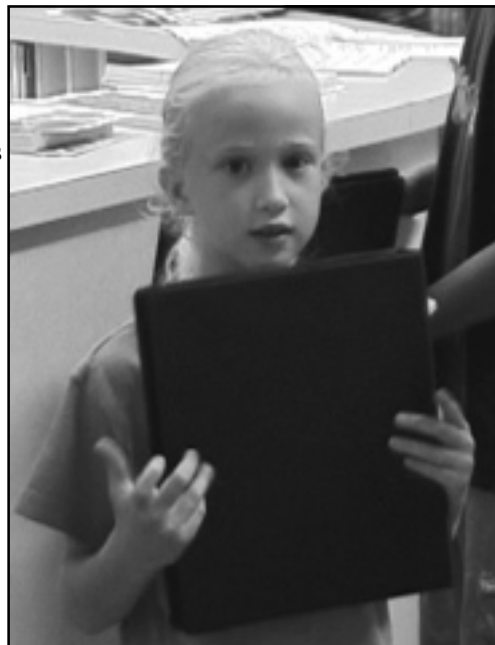
Be sure to read about it on the chapel porch -- and then tell your parents about it. But, that is then, and now it is the beginning of Choral Camp 2001. Have fun!

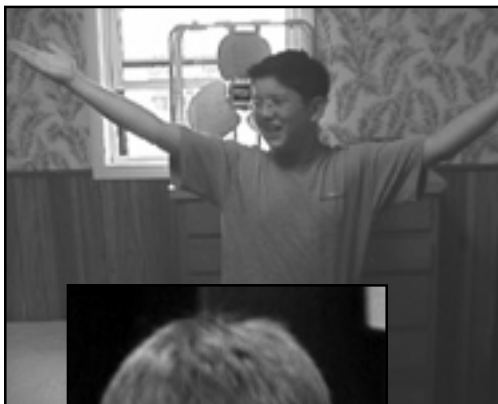

"TAP"

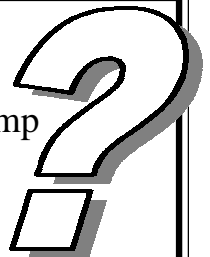
A class in which music theory and appreciation are taught and compositions are practiced
