Abigail and Brittney were going to the carnival to decide whether

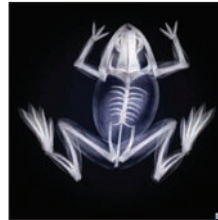
they should eat the frog they had caught, or to let it go.

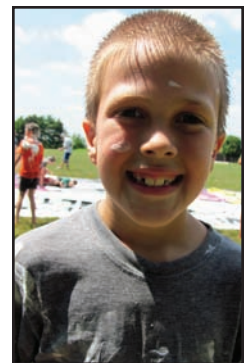
Kerry

Siblings also play a role in bringing kids to Choral Camp. Jansen Martin, from Litiz, Pa., blamed his brothers for his interest in coming to camp,



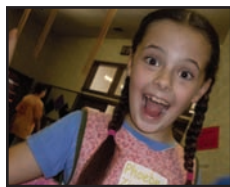
