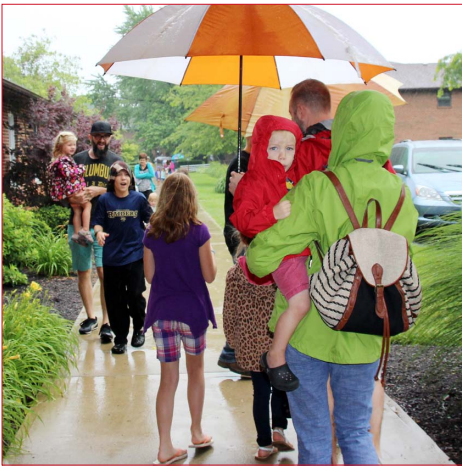

I talked to Noah after the game. His words were: "It was fun!"

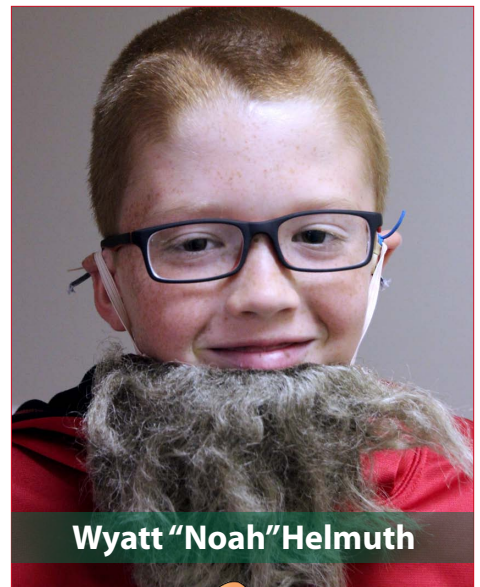
Truly a game of the ages.

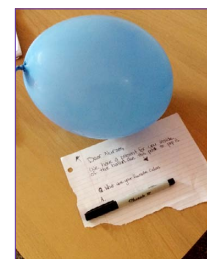
