Camper Julia Heatwole may not realize it, but she is a "born archivist." That's what Rosedale Bible College's Director of Library Services Reuben Sairs says, and he should know, because librarians know that kind of thing.

What is an archivist? It's somebody who takes care of public records and historical documents. One person said, "Being an archivist is fun . . . if you like to read other people's mail."

But others have a more noble view of the matter, like Pat M. Neff, the 28th Governor of Texas and ninth President of Baylor University. He said, "The preservers of history are as heroic as its makers."

What does all this have to do with Julia? You may have noticed that she wears a cute little pouch over her shoulder everywhere she goes. It's about the size of a passport and is fetchingly decorated with teal designs.

It turns out that Camper Allison Beachy gave Julia the pouch two years ago. Now Julia uses it to carry all the Choral Camp *Records* for the last two years (plus this year's as well).
