After being tortured with dishsoap,



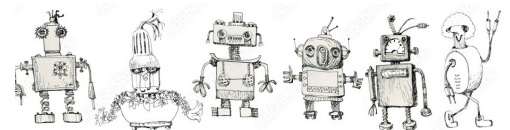
stiltons, and shaving cream, one Crew member named Sam confessed, "Okay! Every night we take the counselors and plug them into the wall."
