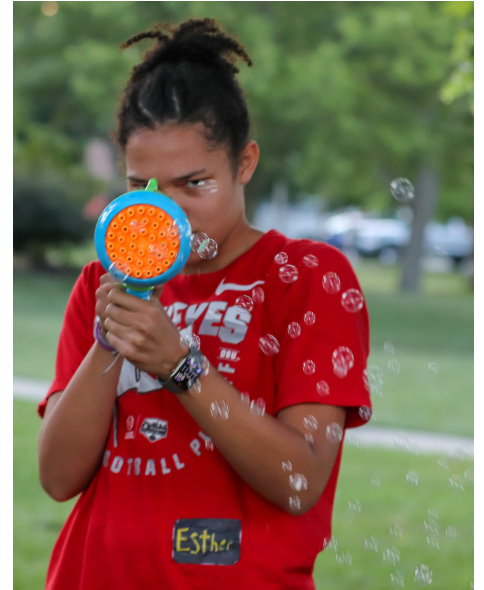
Rebellious Counselor poses threat to Choral Camp!
