More than Meets the Eye

On our way to Choral camp we stopped at my in-laws in Indiana, and in a stump in their front yard, I came across one of the strangest-looking creatures I've ever picked up-- a larva of the Eastern Eyed Click Beetle. It was nearly two inches long, with a tough, segmented body that looked more like something from a science fiction movie than a future beetle. It was fun to hold!

If you saw it, you probably wouldn't call it beautiful. But that's because this isn't the finished product. After its transformation, this unusual larva will become an Eastern Eyed Click Beetle, complete with two large "eye spots" that help protect it from predators. What looks ordinary now is becoming something remarkable.

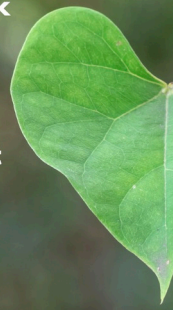
