By bedtime, campers were already telling stories about the surprise visitor, and everyone agreed it had made the first night of camp much more memorable.

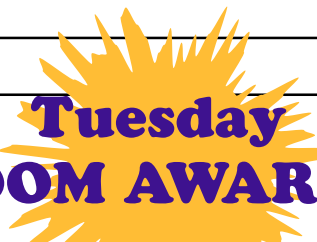

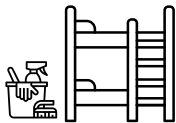
